District 60 Report - Ernie reported we need help for someone else to run the Race Committee, so we work with the Cleveland Foundry, which is the high school community sailing center. The foundry is organizing and adjusting to support racing better. They have to bring-in cash to pay the race committee - \$50 dollars for 6-8 weeks. Hopefully they will get back to 2 nights/week. Ernie said he had 2 boats sold and 3 boats renovated in the last year. Potential for more sailors joining us next year

District 65 Report – Lenny reports there were 11 boats at the Southern Comfort the first day at Lake Julian in Ashville, NC. Then it blew up and some went home or didn't race.
